1) Safety Presentation

General response protocol -common practice for all NYC school

- -you get info when we do drill
- "Lockdown"
- 2 different types
- a. Soft lock down- no immediate danger/all kids are trained out of sight, stay silent, safety officer does sweep check)
- b. Hard lockdown -specific danger in the building (no sweeping, no movement)
- Kids are told it is practice, they are not scared when practice

Other drill

- c. Fire drill exit practice
- d. Evacuation drill (can't come back to the building)
- -White safety holder has everyone's important information (custody. Medication, etc) Located right at entrance of the classroom (travel with children to lunchroom so on)
- e. Shelter-in drill

Something happened in the neighborhood, no movement to get out of the building but inside of the building there is movement

- -no parents in/out of the building
- f. Hold
- no movement around the building but the school is not "lockdown"
- we just don't want kids in the hallway
- g. Blue drill (for staffs who are trained CPR/APD trained to do the simulation) get score
- We have 12 staffs trained (minimum required is 4) get perfect score
- ADD machine is equipped in both buildings

Medication card (medication info)

- Epipen stay with classroom teacher
- Classroom teacher is trained

Safety, other info

- We now have the buzzer system at the door that DOE installed
- When we evacuate all our evacuate location (other school) can accommodate us
- All parents are informed where and when to pick up kids
- -Power points and lesson plan (for teacher) are posted on the NYDOE website and are public

- -Key to lock the classrooms are right next to the door
- The kids are trained to ask for help if teacher is not
- Parents are encouraged to sign up "Notify NYC"
- 2) PTA Taking vote
